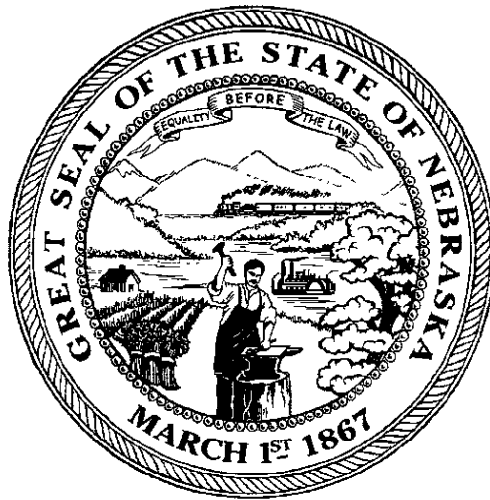

Reported Problems

Sioux County

North Platte Natural Resource Subdistrict 2 was not on the ballot. Although 53 voters did not receive the ballot, it did not impact the outcome due to the margin between second and third place.

Jefferson County

Ballots in the Buckley-Antelope-Endicott precinct only had one set of judge's initials rather than the statutory two sets. Total number of voters impacted include: 155 Republicans, 51 Democrats, and 7 Non Partisan. The error did not impact any state or local race due to winning margins.

Douglas County

Two precincts in Omaha had pollbooks that only contained about half of the registered voters for the precinct. Several voters (estimated at about 40) were turned away rather than allowed to vote provisionally. The problem was corrected by 10AM.

One precinct did not open until approximately 8:15 AM. There is no estimate of the number of voters impacted.
